Present: Supervisor Edward Bishop, Councilmen: Matt Paton, Bill Smith, Janet Tyler and Tony Bruno. Also present, William Holvig, Supt. of Highways and Town Attorney Robert Kruger. Town Clerk Kimberly Sullivan was excused.

The meeting was opened with a flag salute.

This special meeting is being called for the purpose of approving 2019-2020 Snow Contract with Montgomery County.

In Public Comment:

1. In the preamble on page one, we would like the wording "of removing" changed to "of reducing".
2. On page 2 section 2b the "shall clear" should be changed to read "reasonably clear".
3. On page 2 section 2c please include what the data will be used for and the date due to the commissioner should be changed to March 1st of the following year.
4. On page 2 section 2e, delete all after the word requirements.
5. On page 2 section 2g, keep the first sentence and remove the rest or reword it so that it makes more sense.
6. On page 3 section 2i, remove the last sentence or fix section g so that it makes sense. Also, please include that the Town of Mohawk will not be held responsible for damage to the new section of Hickory Hill Road as stated in my letter to the commissioner earlier this year.

Resolution #054 Authorization for the Town Supervisor to approve a two year Snow Contract with Montgomery County was tabled.

A motion to adjourn the Special meeting at 8:00pm was made by Smith and seconded by Paton. All present voting in favor, motion carried.
