Regular Monthly Meeting
April 12th, 2018 7:00pm

The regular monthly meeting was held on April 12th, 2018 at the Richard A. Papa Office Building, 2-4 Park St. Fonda NY 12068.

The meeting was opened with a flag salute.

A motion to approve the minutes of the 03/08/18 Regular Meeting was made Bruno and seconded by Tyler. All present voting in favor, motion carried.

Public Comment:

Frank Garti, a resident of Westminister Drive, thanked the board as well as Bill Holvig for ditching completed on the abandoned property by his home. He is hopeful that it will be maintained now that spring is here.

Alan Buck asked Bill if he could put signage up by the basketball area of the Tribes Hill Park regarding garbage disposal.

Anthony Montenaro of Tribes Hill asked the board if they would convey a piece of property by his home. He had a survey done and our town attorney will look it over.

Participation in Government students Rionnah Simonds and Nicole Rowe both had questions regarding Town Board Minutes and Megan MacDougal asked of the importance of having a Code Enforcement Officer.

Report from the Highway Superintendent as follows:

1. Plow Truck #15 needed a new clutch, steering box and spring. Work was completed and is scheduled to be replaced.
2. Holvig would like permission to post a sign "No Trucks, local delivery only" on Old Johnstown Rd.

3. The men have been cleaning the sand off the roads; he has put a good dent in his budget by our extreme winter in both man power and materials.
4. Bill will be gathering numbers for prospective paving.
5. The signs for Mohawk Drive are ready and just need to be put up.
6. The NYS budget has been passed. CHIPS money: \$72,409.63, Pave NY: \$16,526.88, Extreme Winter Recovery: \$13,982.41 for a total of: \$102,918.92

A motion to allow Highway Superintendent Holvig to put up signs "No Trucks, Local Delivery Only" on Old Johnstown Rd. was made by Paton and seconded by Smith. All present voting in favor, motion passed.

Sole Assessor, Stella Gittle had nothing to add.

Brief discussion was held on the replacement of our Code/Zoning Officer. The Code Officer has 6 required courses that are 21 hours each. The board decided to advertise for the Code Enforcement Officer immediately and eventually the Zoning Position.

A motion to advertise the Code Officer position with qualifications in both the Recorder newspaper and on our website was made by Smith and seconded by Paton. All present voting in favor, motion passed.

A draft Residency Law for full time employees was read and discussed by section. There will be changes made the rewritten final draft will be ready for next month's meeting. Hwy. Supt. Holvig will show it to the Hwy. Supt.'s attorney for review.

Resolution #026 authorizing the Supervisor, Town Board and Highway Superintendent to audit and pay bills was made by a motion from Smith and seconded by Paton. All present voting in favor, motion passed.
